2. Urgent Business Approval of Budget

Concrete Slab for Kindy Bike Track

YourMove Platinum Grant (up to \$7000) must be used by end of June 2021. Therefore, concrete base must go in ASAP. Two quotes received — one for just under \$2000 and another for approximately \$6000. P&C members with links to the industry suggest \$2000 is a reasonable quote for the work to be completed.
