PRINCIPAL'S REPORT



North Morley Primary School P&C Principal's Report April 21, 2021



1. Ceilings in Senior block and Pre-Primary, After school care have been replaced over the holidays. These were completed on Sunday 18 April – the staff worked hard to get the rooms ready for the Tuesday for the students.
2. Wish List: The finance committee is still to meet to prioritise the items.
3. Our ANZAC service is this Friday at 9:00am
4. Currently we have 3 student teachers in the school – in Pre-primary, Year 4/5 and Year 5/6. They are completing their block pracs this term.
5. Chaplain: our new chaplain will start in week 3. Domenica Casci has worked for Youthcare for 16 years. She will be available on Mondays.
6. National Simultaneous Storytime: this will be held on Wednesday, May 19 at 9:00am. The whole school will listen to the reading of “Give Me Some Space”. There are several activities involved with the book to develop the students’ interest.
7. Australian Early Development Census will be happening in May. The AEDC is a nationwide census of early childhood development that measures the progress of children as they start their first year of full time school. It is completed by the pre-primary teacher.
8. National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) begins on May 11. This involves all year 3, 5, 7 and 9 students in Australia. Our year 3 and 5 students have been preparing for this assessment. NAPLAN was cancelled last year due to Covid. NAPLAN tests skills that are essential for every child to progress through school and life, such as reading, writing, spelling and numeracy.
9. Swimming lessons: this year we are doing swimming at Swan Active in Beechboro. The pool is undercover and heated – but much smaller than Terry Tyzack. There are 3 swimming sessions happening in the morning. Information will come out by the start of week 3 – May 3
