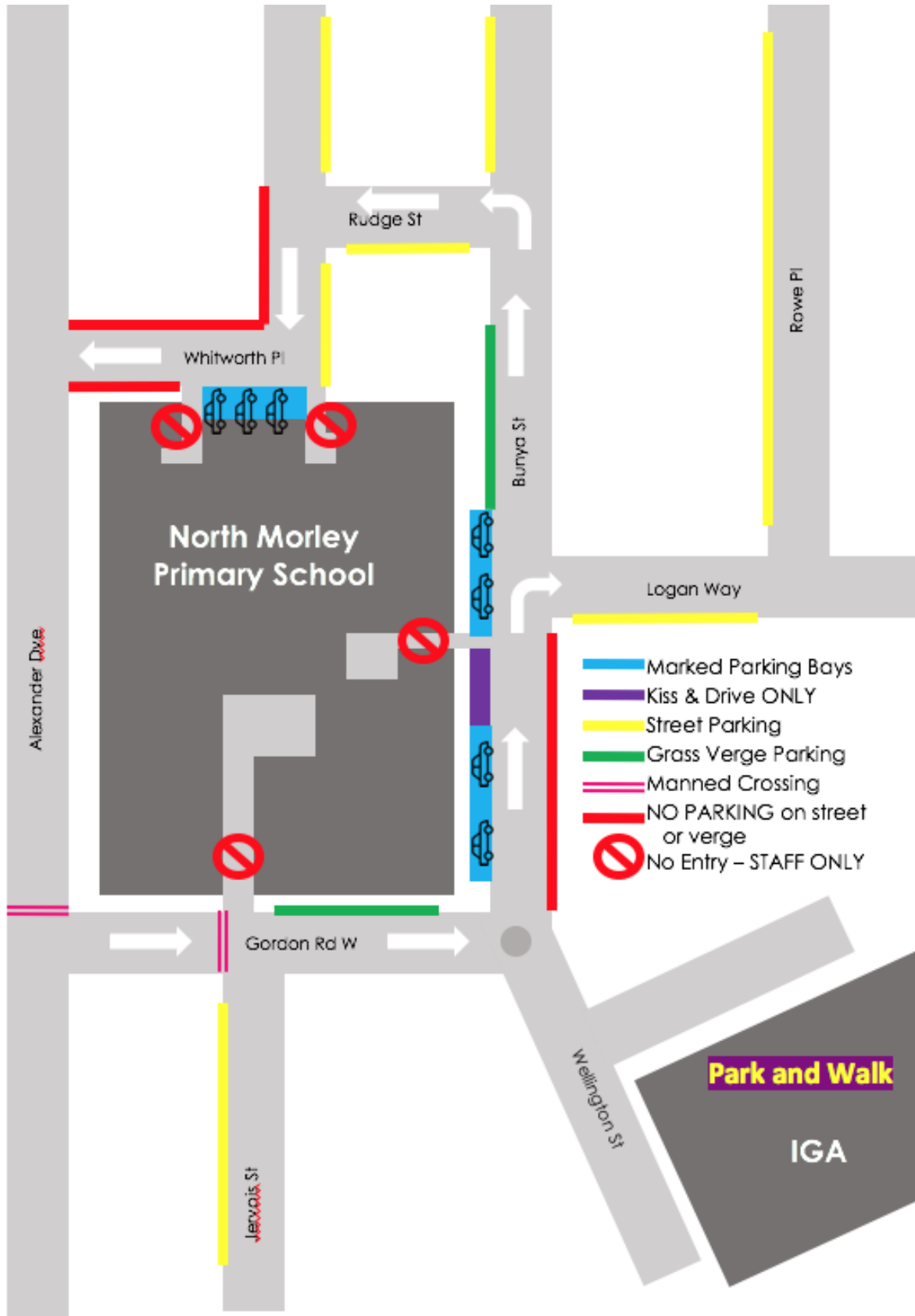


PARKING NOTICE

The following map shows you where you can and cannot park around the school. It also shows the direction traffic should flow around the school.



At North Morley Primary School parents and local citizens work together to keep our children safe. This means EVERYONE respecting our parking rules and flow of traffic around the school at the busy drop off and pick up times.

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO?

- Wherever possible – walk or cycle to school.
- Think about parking nearby and walking a short distance to school.
- Plan your trip so you arrive on the correct side of the school – please avoid U-turns and reversing from driveways! This is a major hazard and causes congestion during busy drop off and pick up times.
- Slow down around school and be aware.
- Set good examples for everyone around your school parking area by being courteous to other drivers, being patient and responsible.
- If you see unlawful parking – report it!

- Please follow the arrows which show how traffic should flow around the school.
- DO NOT park in the KISS AND DRIVE – if your child is not ready, please do a lap around the school.

OBEY PARKING RULES AT ALL TIMES

- DO NOT park in driveways or on verges across from the school.
- DO NOT double park.
- DO NOT park facing the wrong way down the street.
- Adhere to parking signs.
